Purchasing environmentally preferable (EPP) toner cartridges can be difficult and time consuming for public sector purchasers that aren't up-to-date with the remanufactured toner cartridge industry and toner cartridge specifications or bid language that reflects the current marketplace.

The *Monochrome Toner Cartridges: Model EPP Specifications and Purchasing Guidelines* includes information and language that can be used in part, or in its entirety, in bid documents and vendor contracts to identify available EPP monochrome toner cartridges that meet the highest EPP specifications.
