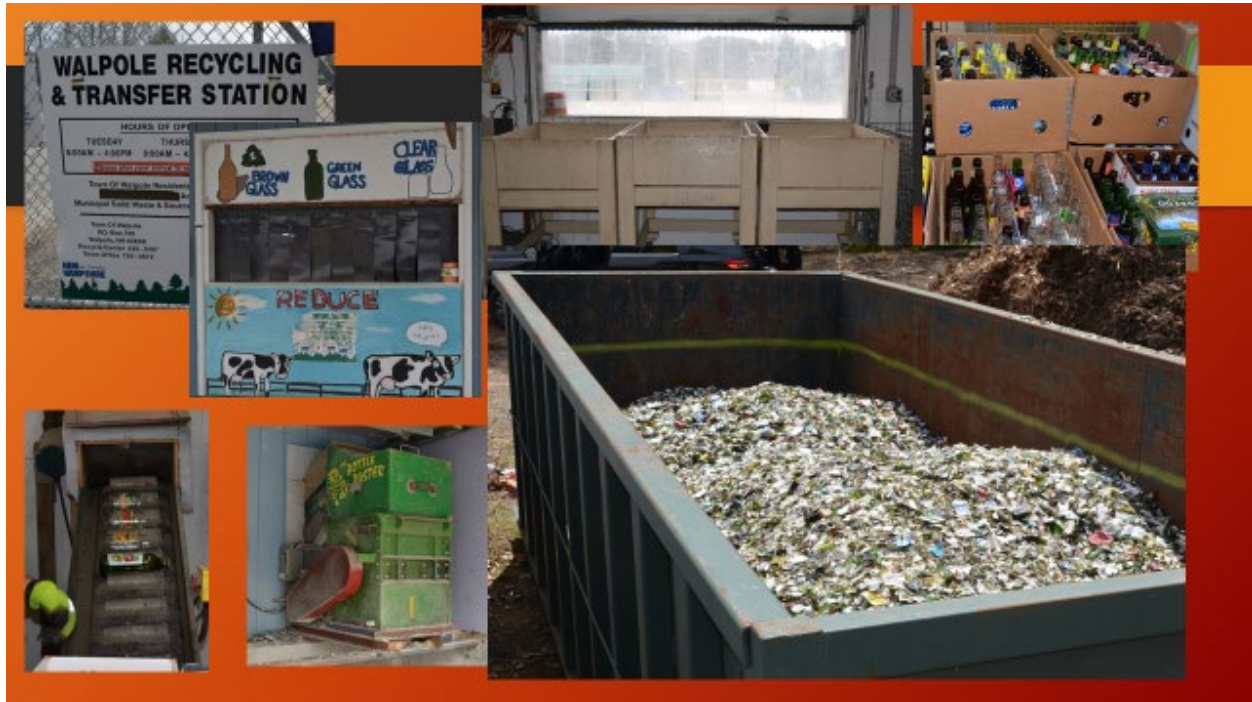


Glass Recycling Program Case Study

Walpole Recycling & Transfer Station

Population: 3,863

Glass Accepted for Recycling: Residential, source separated, clean glass containers

On-Site Processing: Each glass container received is placed on a conveyor that carries the glass to the glass bottle breaker machine (*The Bottle Buster*). The broken glass is transferred to an outside dumpster for storage.

Current Market: Northeast Resource Recovery Association's (NRRRA) Clean Glass Program. NRRRA is responsible for crushing the glass for shipping and then it's sent for further processing to make it ready for fiberglass manufacturers.

2021 Tonnage of Glass Collected: 45 tons (90,000 lbs.)

2021 Glass Recycling Rate Per Capita: 23 lbs./person
