Boulder Food Rescue

- Started in 2011
- Began with evidence-based research with local Feeding America Food Bank, Community Food Share
- Found enough food was going to waste to feed every hungry person in Boulder and County
- Gaps in Food Redistribution Model
- Direct, Just-in-time model created
- Focus on healthy, uncut fruits and vegetables
- Bicycle-powered food recovery nonprofit

Working With Retailers

- Persistence with building relationships
- Finding solutions that work for the businesses is key
- Sorting through food with the power of volunteers
- Flexible hours, days and just-in time recovery



Some Numbers

- 1,300 lbs. of food moved per day in Boulder alone
- 10 donors
- 35 recipients
- 1.5 million pounds of food recovered so far
- 150 volunteers

Food Rescue Robot:

- Logistics Software
- Tracks schedule and volunteers
- Records data from pick-ups
- Gives volunteers autonomy to take shifts and know how to do shifts
- Generates receipts for donors

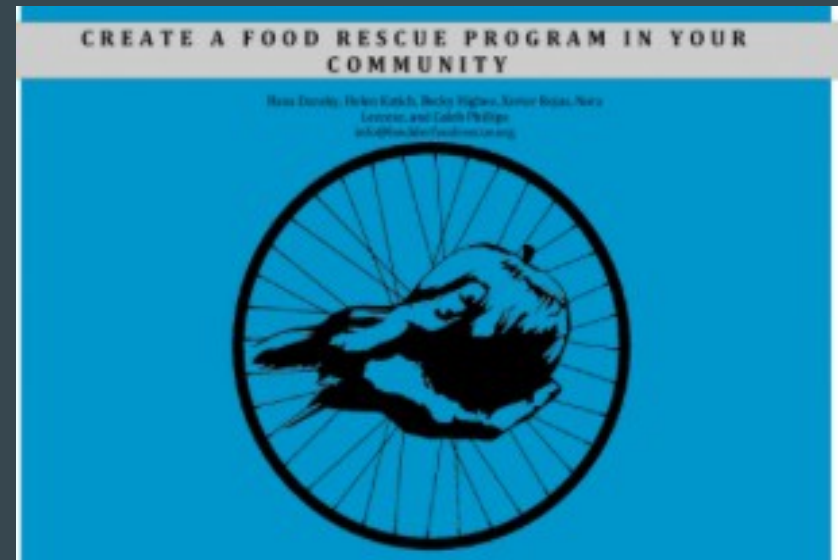
