Mapping Reciprocal Partnerships

- 1) Using the attached Reciprocal Partnership Map or make your own (such as on a flip chart), by drawing a circle in the middle and write "Community Composting Site" inside.
- 2) On the outside edges of the circle write the names of partners or potential partners your group identifies and draw a box around each of them.
- 3) Brainstorm ways that each partner can help develop and maintain the community composting site. For example, a local Carpenter's Union member or Eagle Scout, might be a partner willing to build a compost bin, tool shed, and/or fencing.
- 4) Draw an arrow connecting each partner to the Community Composting Site circle the way you envision their involvement.
- 5) Brainstorm what the Community Composting Site can offer each partner. For example, an opportunity to bring food scraps to the site for composting; free compost; training in composting.
