- 1. Abstract (350 words or less sent as a Microsoft Word or PDF file)
  - a. Detail the proposed presentation content and specify the topic listed above in which it fits
  - b. Specify if and when you have presented the topic at another event (include event name, location, and date)
- 2. Speaker bio & contact information (must include cell phone number and email address)
- 3. Headshot (JPG file)
